



Speaker Training

Help learners create a connection to their audience

This session aims to aid participants in personalizing their speech using personal attributes of themselves to create a more personal, humanized way of speaking that will be more effective, means of communicating their thoughts and emotions to others.

Make effective use of the learner's voice

Next, participants will know how learner's voice becomes a significant tool to their arsenal, and one such tool that this course will train learners in proper and effective usage in.

Promote efficiency, retention, and cohesiveness in speech

Lastly, participants will learn the techniques and methods to allow speakers to stay on topic, make their points in the most efficient ways possible, allow speakers to maintain their composure and attention in settings or environments that would easily draw attention away from or distract them from their speaking activity, or at the very least allow them to substitute stammering phrases with ones that allow them to return to the topic at hand more efficiently.
