



Project Management Fundamentals

Project Goals

Before starting with project planning, it is crucial to establish a vision of what you aim to achieve. Lets delve into the idea of a vision statement and provide guidance on how to craft one. After that participants will collaborate in groups to come up with a vision, for a sample project. During this session we'll explore the six components of project goals and participants will get a chance to draft goals for their projects.

Using a Target Chart

Utilizing a target chart can be incredibly helpful in identifying priorities within your project and devising strategies to achieve your goals. In this session we'll walk you through the process of creating and utilizing a target chart.

Preparing Your Project

Once you have decided which project to promote to others and have identified your vision and goals it's important to be prepared. Participants will discuss six considerations, in groups.

Organizing the Project

Now that we have an understanding of what our project entails, we can create the Project Charter and Work Statement.
